## CALL FOR PAPERS

The Victoria Press seeks essays on the subject of Latino Muslims in the United States and abroad for inclusion in an anthology to be released during the summer of 2009. In light of the lack of scholarly treatment of this subject, this anthology is an effort to fill a need for scholarship which addresses the experiences, cultural encounters, religious transformations and accompanying issues of the growing Latino Muslim population.

Essays should be scholarly in nature and authors should hold a current professorial post in a related area of study such as religion, cultural studies, sociology, psychology, etc.; retired and former professors are also invited to submit essays. Previously published essays will be accepted; however, authors are responsible for securing any permission required for the reprinting of an essay.

### **Essay specifications:**

- **Length:** Essays should be 2,500-4,000 words.
- **Footnotes/Endnotes:** Endnotes are required. Footnoted essays will not be accepted.
- **File type:** Essays should be submitted via email in PDF, MS Word, or Rich Text File format.
- **References:** APA style is highly preferred. Acceptable styles also include MLA and Chicago. Consistency in style throughout the essay is required.
- **Publication ready:** Essays submitted for consideration must be "Publication Ready," or rather, in their final form. Essays which are not "publication ready" will not be accepted. Essay proposals will not be considered.

### **Author requirement:**

- Authors must submit a Curriculum Vitae along with their essay.

### **Essay submission:**

- Submit the final and complete essay, along with a C.V., to [editor@thevictoriapress.com](mailto:editor@thevictoriapress.com). *(Authors will receive an acknowledgement of receipt and will be notified by December 1, 2009, of the decision to include or not include their essay in this anthology.)*
